NOTICE TO MEMBERS

Due to the unforeseen events of 2020 with regards to the COVID19 pandemic, the Board of Directors and Club General Manager have had to make necessary alterations to the Terms & Conditions of our Astra LS Promotion. These changes have been made under the right the Club reserves in all promotions to alter said promotion when force majeure presents.

We have restricted any changes to those only necessary to ensure this promotion is fair to all members but does not risk the health and safety of any involved or risk breaking any currently enforced COVID19 laws or restrictions.

Eligibility

Entry in The Musicians Club ASTRA LS PROMOTION is open to all Members of the Broken Hill Musicians Club Ltd whom are financial at the time of entry and at the time of the draw and must be over the age of 18.

Broken Hill Musicians Club employees, immediate family members of employees and club directors are ineligible to enter.

Entry

The promotion re-commences at 10am on Monday the 2 November 2020 and will be drawn weekly from Friday the 22nd of November on Wednesdays and Friday nights after the Meat Draw.

To enter, eligible entrants simply need to spend \$5 in the Broken Hill Musicians Club on Food & Beverage and present their Membership Card at the time of purchase. Every \$5 spent per transaction will generate an automatic ticket entry in the promotion. Excludes entry via gaming.

Prizes & Winning

WEEKLY FINALIST DRAWS

Commencing Friday Nov 22nd 2 weekly draws will take place as we search for 2 weekly finalists.

To WIN a weekly Finalist Position we will draw one ticket from the entry barrel between 5:30PM and 8:30PM Wednesdays and Fridays.

The Member drawn does not need to be in the club to claim a remaining finalist position.

A member can only WIN one (1) Finalist Position each. If an existing finalist is drawn a second time that entry is forfeit and will be redrawn immediately.

Once all 30 finalists positions have been awarded, those finalists will be invited to a special final draw night where we can conduct a COVID safe final draw to see who will be the grand prize winner of the Holden Astra LS.

MAJOR DRAW NIGHT

On February 13 2021 we will hold a final drawn night by invitation only. To ensure we keep to a COVID safe environment each finalist will be granted a 2 person pass to the night's event. At 7:30PM all 30 Finalists will be called up one at a time in order of their finalist position (ie. First to WIN - last to WIN). As each finalist is called up they will get to choose one from 1 of the remaining 30 envelopes. Inside each envelope is a card containing the details of their prize.

Prizes will consist of the following;

- 22 x 10,000 Reward Points
- 4 x 25,000 Reward Points

Each Finalist will open their envelope one at a time and reveal their prize until all prizes have been won.

To nominate a proxy the finalist must inform the Musicians Club in writing of their intention to nominate a proxy and the nominated person must provide Photo ID on the night of the draw to confirm their identity.

Winners who receive a prize valued at \$250 or more will have their names published on the Broken Hill Musicians Club Facebook page on the following Monday as per the legal requirements of a trade promotion where the individual prize value exceeds \$250. By claiming a finalist position each member agrees to this legal requirement.

In the event that there remains unawarded prizes on the night of the draw the remaining prizes will be awarded to the absent finalist on a first come first choice basis. At the recommencement of this promotion there have been 11 Members awarded Finalist positions.

Recommencing Friday Nov 22nd the weekly draws will be seeking to award the final 19 Finalist positions.
